

Claiming a Donation Tax Deduction

Where does my donation go?

How do I claim a tax deduction?



1. Make a donation

Make your donation of \$2 or more through any of the methods on our website. We accept one-off or recurring donations using PayPal, Bank transfer, credit or debit card and of course any of our running campaigns on Facebook or Instagram.

2. Save the receipt or invoice

3. Claim your deduction

You can add your deduction on the relevant section of your tax return. Section D9 of your tax return (Gifts or Donations) deals specifically with this type of deduction.
